THIS IS THE LAST WILL of me WILFRED CARDWELL
of 69 Henson Avenue Blackpool in the County of Lancaster Farmer

1. I APPOINT my nephew Stanley Richard Cardwell of 4
Wheatlands Crescent Marton Blackpool aforesaid and my niece
Irene Bradley of St. Annes Road Blackpool aforesaid
(hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and
Trustees of this my Will.

2. I BEQUEATH to my Wife Doreen Joyce Cardwell absolutely free
of duty all articles and effects of personal domestic or
household or garage or garden use ornament or consumption
belonging to me (other than money and securities for money)
and also the sum of Five Hundred Pounds to be paid to her
immediately after my death and in priority to all other
bequests hereby made.

3. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the residue of my estate
and effects whatsoever and wheresoever both real and personal
unto my Trustees UPON TRUST to sell and call in the same but
during the life of my said Wife only with her previous consent
in writing with power to postpone such sale and calling in
indefinitely and to retain the same or any part thereof in
its present form of investment without being responsible for
loss And I Direct that the income of the unsold part thereof
for the time being shall as well during the first year after
my death as afterwards be applied in the same manner as if it
were income of investments of the proceeds of sale and calling
in thereof And my Trustees shall out of the proceeds of such
sale and calling in and out of my ready money pay my funeral

and testamentary expenses and debts and the legacies given by this my Will or any Codicil hereto and the duty on any legacies given free of duty and shall invest the residue of the said moneys in their names in or upon any investments for the time being authorised by law for the investment of trust funds (such moneys and the investments for the time being representing the same being hereinafter called "the trust fund") and shall stand possessed of the trust fund upon the trusts following namely:

4. MY Trustees shall pay the income of the trust fund to my said Wife during her life.

5. AFTER the death of my said Wife my Trustees shall stand -- possessed of the capital and future income of the Trust Fund IN TRUST for such of them my sister Olive Cardwell my nephews the said Stanley Richard Cardwell and Frank Yates and my niece the said Irene Bradley as shall be living at my death and if more than one in equal shares.

6. IF any of my before named residuary legatees shall die in my lifetime leaving a child or children living at my death who being male attain the age of twenty-one years or being female attain that age or marry then and in any such case such child or -- children shall take and if more than one equally between them the share in the Trust Fund which his her or their parent would have taken had he or she survived me.

7. AND I REVOKE all other testamentary dispositions by me heretofore made.
