

How to get to Otter Lake Scout Reserve

Hint: You'll know you're going in the right direction if you keep seeing signs indicating the route to Frontenac Provincial Park.

From Kingston and 401:

Travel North on Sydenham Road (this is exit 613 from the 401) approximately 20 kilometres to T-intersection with flashing lights. Turn left and go aprox. 1 km down hill to the village of Sydenham.

From County Rd. 10 (aka the Perth Road):

Turn West on County Rd 5. County Rd. 5 is aprox. 4 km South of Perth Road village and ½ km North of Loughborough Lake boat ramp. Travel West approximately 6 km to T-intersection with flashing lights. Continue straight and go aprox. 1 km down hill to the village of Sydenham.

From Sydenham:

Watch for the schools on the North side of the road. Turn North at the intersection with the flashing lights that passes between the schools. Proceed down into the village to the next T-intersection and turn right (NorthEast). Continue past the IGA Supermarket and the Beer Store. Follow this road and the signs for Frontenac Provincial Park for about 12 km. The next turn is Salmon Lake Road, watch for Frontenac Outfitters at the SouthEast corner of the T-intersection. Turn East on Salmon Lake Road and proceed aprox. 2 km. Scout Lane is marked with a Scouts Canada sign and is 20 m before the large Frontenac Provincial Park sign. Turn North into Scout Lane to enter the camp. (Note: this winter there has been a lot of frost-heave in the road and it is suggested that low-suspension vehicles drive on the grass and not in the ruts which are quite deep just now.)
