- The camp grass has been moved 4 times this year and will need moving again very soon.
- RVCA inspected the camp and was very happy with what we are doing. We now have permission to have 3 large bales of hay placed at the first large corner leaving the camp to used for a backdrop for archery. This area will need to be leveled somewhat.
- A work party will be required in September to do some major undertakings that were planned and still need to be done such as anew Kybo near the entrance to 1<sup>st</sup> Elmsley's site and repairs to some other kybos. The cost of the new kybo should not be more than \$ 350.00. A backhoe will be required to dig the hole and level the area for archery.
- We have received a donation of \$500.00 from Bell Canada's employee giving fund and I would suggest that we purchase a wipper-snipper with a blade for the camp. This would be used to maintain the campfire area and also to brush along the road and trails. This would cost about \$350.00. One that I looked at is a snapper and its main benefit is that tit has a 4 cycle engine and therefore does not need the oil and gas mixed.
