1) Membership Statistics 2008-2009:

First of all - a few really positive things to report:

Valley Highlands Area had a Total Membership of 373 Members = 99.2% (this is up from a low of 80.7% Growth last year and is only 3 members shy of achieving 100%!)

- 4 Groups reached and exceeded 100% Growth Congratulations to 1st Beckwith, 1st Merrickville, Carleton Place and 1st Elmsley
- The Area's retention was 62% (up from 53.9% the year before!)
- 1 Group reached 70% retention 1st Merrickville

Voyageur Council grew for the third year in a row!

We finished with 100.4% Growth and reached our goal of 65% retention with a total of 65.17% retained.

2) School Postcards 2009:

The school postcards should be arriving by today (Friday) or Monday of next week. They will be bundled and distributed to the schools (as they have been in the past) next week in time for the first day of school. Please see the attached proof of the final Postcard. Throughout the design process, the postcard ended up morphing from a postcard into a much more dynamic "door-hanger" idea - it turned out great!

The website: The website (www.voyageur.scouts.ca/join) is almost ready to go live. Parents will be directed to the website via the postcard and will find listings of Groups and their contacts on the website - much like the back of the flyers had last year. The website was designed to look a lot like the School Postcard to make things simple for parents looking for information.

IMPORTANT - ALL GROUPS - Please find attached the information that we have on file for you from last year and let us know any changes that need to be made to this ASAP. We originally asked for this information back in the Spring but have not yet received anything from Valley Highlands. If we do not get a response from you we will assume the information is correct. Thanks!

As well - the full contest information will be available on the website along with a picture of the prize package.

How the contest works: Anyone who is new to Scouting this year can cut the bottom portion of the postcard off and attach it to their Registration form to be entered into a draw for a \$500 Camping package. Groups - please make sure that you send these cards (filled in completely) in with your registration packages to the office. This will help us track how successful the postcards were in bringing in new membership.

A great deal of time and resources have been invested to meet the demand for these kits – and this tool should be provided to each and every new leader as there is a direct relationship between successful orientation /initial training and new leader retention - so please use them! The Field Executives will be following up with Groups and assessing the usefulness of the kits.
