AC Report:

- **PRCs** continue to be an issue. Group commissioners get out there and find out what the hold up is. Have your Scouter contact the police and find out where it is in the system. 6 months is too long to be waiting!!!
 - **Expiring PRCs** Individual Scouters should go into the system and check their record for expiry date. Start the process 6-8 weeks prior to it expiring.
- **Prospective list** Check your new leaders or see me. Why are they still there? PRC not done? Interview/reference check not done?? Please look into ASAP.
- **E-Learning / WB 1** If you are a new leader and/or new to your section, please complete this ASAP.
- **My Scouts.ca** is now up and running. You will be notified when you can go on to check your records. Let's be diligent in keeping these up to date. If you find a discrepancy, contact Scout Headquarters.
- **Good turn week** April 14 22nd. Orange bracelets have been handed out to your Group Commissioners. These in turn will be given out to each section. Encourage all, including leaders, to do a good turn and when done, pass the bracelet onto that person, and encourage them to do the same.
- **AODA training** Please go on line and complete this. Your Group Commissioner also has the program to present this to you. **Let's see if we can get this done by January 31, 2012!!** No this is not a print error.

- Recruitment Tool Kits Tool kits for Spring registration will be sent out to Group Commissioners. Recruitment Advertising will start April 2nd May 7th.
- A Child & Youth Safety 'Due Diligence' on all our parts is essential. More information will be out on any new measures. Currently all must complete the PRC process, which is the first step in Youth safety.
 - **Discussion re:** Screening and how to protect the children and leaders. If leaders are uncomfortable talk about it. We have a different set of rules than in the past in order to do our best to ensure youth safety.
- * **Merrickville Group Commissioner** Hope Gray will be stepping down in June. I'm pleased to report that **Keith Skelhorne** will be replacing her for the upcoming year.

Council Meeting Report:

CHILD & YOUTH SAFETY: A meeting was held on March 7th at Headquarters regarding our current methods of implementing different aspects of Youth Safety. Barry Hardaker, CEO and Mike Jowett, Council Commissioner will be travelling to Toronto (March 24/25) to participate with other Council Commissioners on this subject. Up-dating procedures and other issues that need to be in place will be discussed then.

Random Checks: As part of the Service Team's mandate, we are to visit groups periodically and see how things are functioning. At this time we will also be checking on Safety aspect, 2-deep leadership; ratio; as well as program. A report is filed at Headquarters afterwards.

PRC issues – This is an ongoing - Scouters will have to be more diligent in making sure they have an up-to-date PRC and make arrangements to get a new one prior to the other expiring. It is not up to your Group Commissioner to do this for you. Once everyone has signed into **myscouts.ca**, we are hoping this will be automatically generated to remind you. If your PRC expires, the system will automatically put you as "inactive" and you will be asked to <u>remove your uniform.</u> You may still participate in the program as long as two other Scouters with PRCs are in the same room. However, you must get the PRC asap.

Myscouts.ca – is now up and running, HOWEVER, there are some glitches, as with all new programs. If you do not get through when you first log in, please be patient, as the system is trying to deal with everyone. If you have difficulties, **do use the 'Help'** segment, and they will respond as soon as they can.

** **Spring registration:** Myscouts.ca is now set for Spring registration. If your group has not signed up for this to happen, you will have to let your parents know. This will make things easier for Group Registrars, as parents pay upon registration, thus the group will not have to deal with that portion. Each group need to let Headquarters know their fee, which will be put into the system. When the parent registers, the funds then will be sent to National, Council and your portion put directly into the Group Account.

Training calendar – is now up and running. They have four registered courses on there, including WB II. You register by signing into **myscouts.ca**, click on training and register.
