Turn left at the next street - Home Street (TD Canada Trust building in on the corner)

Head south to Water Street, turn right and head west

Continue west on Water Street to Henry Street

Turn left (south) on Henry Street... the Museum is the only building on Henry Street.

Parking is in the lot just past the Museum (south side of the Museum)
