| 1. | Travel on Highway #15 to the intersection with Chaffey's Locks Road , about two kilometres north of Elgin, Ontario, or about one kilometre south of Crosby, Ontario. There is a business called <u>Franklin's Cars and Crafts</u> on the south-west corner of this intersection. | 0.0 |
| 2. | Turn onto Chaffey's Locks Road and go west. At 0.2 km you will pass Crosby Road on the right. Go straight ahead to the intersection with Garrett Road . A Scouts Canada Camp Folly sign is on a tree on Garrett Rd. | 1.4 |
| 3. | Turn right and go north on Garrett Road to the intersection with Clear Lake Road . Another Camp Folly sign is on a post at the corner. | 2.3 |
| 4. | Turn left onto Clear Lake Road and go west to the intersection with Pine Glen Road . A Scouts Canada tacker sign and arrow is on a post. | 3.7 |
| 5. | You will see the Camp Folly sign on the right side almost immediately after turning onto Pine Glen Road. There is a parking area behind the sign, with access to a campground area and hiking trail, addressed as 11 Pine Glen Rd . | |
| 6. | Continue along Pine Glen Road to the entrance of Pine Glen Lodge , which lies straight ahead. Folly Road (which is a private road) continues after a turn to the right. At the next turn in the road is a right hand entrance into another campground area addressed as 41 Folly Road . The entrance into the lakeside campsite area of Camp Folly is the second driveway on the right, but is some distance ahead. | 4.8 |
| 7. | You will pass a number of cottages along the left side of the road. Each property number is posted on a small blue sign with white numbers at the driveway. The driveway entrance into the lakeside campsite area of Camp Folly is on the right, marked with number 249 . | 6.0 |
| 8. | You will reach a small clearing at each side of the road with an earth cliff ahead on the right. There is a small parking lot on the left, with a shed, and a slightly larger parking area on the right. Park here, and on foot, descend the path leading down the hill to the left toward the lake. You will find the group campfire area and then, further along toward the point, the lakeside campsite. | 6.2 |

Note: The property farther along this driveway is not part of Camp Folly, but is a private cottage addressed 247. Please do not drive further down this driveway, and do not block travel along the driveway for others. Enjoy your stay at Camp Folly!
