### Platoon Leader Instructions

- Cubs should have a ration pack lunch made by a group other than their own.
- Your platoon is highlighted in the table above and your starting activity is marked on the map.
- Let Cubs figure out the way from one activity to the next.
- 10 minutes are allocated for moving between activities. Don't be late! A horn will sound when it is time to move, but don't depend on hearing it.
- Where trails are to be followed to activities, they will be marked with yellow flagging tape.
- Eat lunch where ever you happen to be at lunch time (let the Cubs pick the place). Encourage Cubs to trade food items. Cubs with severe allergies will have a ration pack with their name on it. Setup a tarp in the case of inclement weather.
- Encourage your Cubs to demonstrate proper military behaviour and etiquette. i.e. saluting, marching, standing at attention. Some leaders will have shell casings for rewarding this behaviour.
- Loading rubber band guns: Clip rubber band on clothes pin, give band a half twist and hook over end of gun.
- Three whistle blasts signify an emergency.
- Pickup any rubber bands found on the ground.
- Upon completion of the day, please return clipboard to GCHQ or Campsite #10 (1<sup>st</sup> Merrickville).
