

# Valley Highlands Area Cub Camp Impeesa Schedule

May 2006

## Schedule

### Friday

- 7:00pm : Cub Packs arrive at camp.
- 8:00pm – 9:00pm : Informal campfire for Cubs and leaders at the main camp fire circle. Opportunity for the adults and kids to mix and mingle. Treats provided (but not mug-up).  
Straw bale maze on the parade ground.
- 9:00pm : Leader meeting at GCHQ. At least one leader from each Pack must attend, but preferably more. Volunteers will be needed to take platoons around and to help with some of the activities. Bring payment of \$7/Cub and \$2 for each extra crest desired. Bring ration packs for each of your Cubs (and leaders who will be traveling with a platoon). Packs will be issued crests, identity discs, rubber band guns, and rubber band ammunition for each Cub. Platoon leaders will be issued rotation schedule, map, and an identifying arm band. Medic arm bands will be distributed for leaders with first aid certification.

### Saturday

- 8:45am : Opening on parade ground. No uniform. Camouflage clothing encouraged. Cubs need a small knapsack to carry their ration pack lunch.  
Divide Cubs into platoons based on the first number on their identity disc.  
Cubs given ration pack lunch
- 9:30am – 5:00pm : Activity rotation by platoon. Lunch is one of the activities; Cubs will eat with their platoon.
- 5:00pm – 7:00pm : Free time and supper. Secret leader test at each campsite. Have songs/skits/cheers ready.
- 7:00pm – 8:00pm : Wide game (Smugglers & Spies); meet at parade ground.
- 8:00pm – 8:30pm : Leader assault course competition.
- 8:00pm – 9:00pm : Free time.
- 9:00pm – 9:30pm : Formal campfire; meet at parade ground. Each Pack to be prepared with one song/skit/cheer per six Cubs in their Pack. Each person to bring their mug.
- 9:30pm – 10:00pm : Mug-up; drink and snack on parade ground.

### Sunday

- 9:00am : March past inspection on parade ground. Bring your Pack flag. Full uniform. Drill demonstrations by Packs. Come with count of shells earned (don't bring shells, Cubs get to keep them).  
Camp review.  
Seven challenge award presentations.  
Impeesa trophy presentation.
- 10:00am : Closing.  
: Cleanup.

## Notes

- Recommend marking the rubber band guns with the Pack name and Cub's name.
- Loading rubber band guns: Clip rubber band on clothes pin, give band a half twist and hook over end of gun.

## Cubs should have in their knapsack

- Rubber band gun
- Rubber band ammunition
- Water bottle, full (optional)
- Snacks (optional)

## Cleanup

- After closing on Sunday, help is requested for any final tear down of the aerial runway, the obstacle course, the field gun race, and all camp related signage and flagging tape.
