Our annual winter Cub camp is rapidly approaching. As a change this year we will be using the Rock Dunder Scout camp just outside Morton. This is a beautiful location on the Rideau River. The Cubs will be spending all day outside so ensure they are dressed appropriately. In the event of severe cold temperature, many activities will take place inside the heated cabin.

Potential activities include: quinzles, snowball fight with forts, tree identification, emergency shelters, snow shoe races, silly olympics, lashing camp gadgets, tracking, hiking, fire lighting, wide games.

The Cubs will be sleeping in log cabin heated with a wood stove. They have the option of sleeping outside if a parent or other adult is present.

The consent form and payment is due no later than Wednesday **February 1st**. Method of payment is cash or cheque payable to “Mike Jackman”. We need an accurate attendance figure to purchase the food.

A kit list for winter camping is attached. There is a 1km hike from the road to the cabin, so the Cub’s kit should be packed in a rucksack they can carry and/or lashed to a toboggan.

A map to the camp is attached. It is a 65km (~50 minute) drive from Merrickville.
