The Baxter Conservation Area is between Manotick and Kemptville off Highway 416. Use Exit#42 then east on Dilworth Road. Baxter is 3 km ahead on the right. Once on site, you will be directed to the registration area.

Important items to note:

- 1. \$25.00 non-refundable deposit per pack is a commitment to attending. This will also allow time for monies to be collected from youth/parents.
- 2. If participants would like to link with another pack, please let us know.
- 3. A list of the programs with a brief description of each is listed below for your review. Once we have received your registrations with your choices of activities, we will plot out the schedule for your pack for the weekend.
