

# Registration Parent Instructions



September 2003

Complete and sign youth registration form.

- Please list an email address if possible.
- Ensure that both a full street address and PO Box/Rural Route number are given.

Complete and sign physical fitness form for youth.

If your child will be in Cubs or Scouts, and would like to participate in the Soapbox Derby on Sunday September 28<sup>th</sup>, please complete and sign the Soapbox Derby consent form. There is no additional cost for this activity, which will include a lunch, a crest, and racing our Scout built Soapbox cars on St. Lawrence Street.

- This form must be completed and submitted tonight.

Complete volunteer interest form.

- We are in desperate need of additional leaders. Three leaders moved out of the area over the summer. Commitment to attend each weekly meeting is NOT necessary. The section leaders will be happy to answer any of your questions.

Visit the uniform and book table.

- Decide on size of uniform for the youth – better too big than too small!
- Decide on appropriate books.
- Uniforms and books are picked up at the financial table upon payment.
- No returns after September 30<sup>th</sup>.

Visit the financial table

- Submit all forms.
- Submit payment for registration, uniforms, and books.
  - Registration cost is \$123 for the first youth, and \$99 for each subsequent youth in the same family.
  - Cases of hot chocolate may be purchased for \$48 each. \$25 registration credit for the first case, and \$24 credit for each case there after. Each case contains eight boxes of hot chocolate that retail for \$6 a piece. The hot chocolate may be sold to recoup your full cost.
  - Cheques may be postdated to September 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - No refunds after September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Pickup uniforms, books, and hot chocolate.
