## Forms

- Please list an email address if possible. We use this for communicating activity information.
- Ensure that both a full street address and PO Box/Rural Route number are given.

## Be a leader!

- We are in need of additional Cub and Scout leaders.
- Multiple leaders are having to attend both Cub and Scout meetings.
- Commitment to attend each weekly meeting is NOT necessary.

## Uniform

- Full uniform is mandatory for all youth.
  - Beavers: Vest and hat.
  - Cubs: Tan shirt, Cub sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Cub handbook.
  - Scouts: Tan shirt, Scout sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Scout handbook.
- The trousers/shorts must be a solid colour: no stripes, flowers, embroidery, etc.
- The Scout field book is highly recommended for Scouts.
- No returns after September 30<sup>th</sup>.

## Cost

- Registration cost is \$125 for the first youth, and \$100 for each subsequent youth in the same family.
- Of this amount, \$100 per child goes to Scouts Canada for their administrative costs and \$25 per family stays with the group to help with the program.
- Cheques may be postdated to September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- No refunds after September 30<sup>th</sup>.

## Meetings

- All meetings are at the Merrickville Community Centre unless previously communicated.
  - Beavers Tuesday 6:30pm – 7:45pm starts September 21<sup>st</sup>
  - Cubs Wednesday 6:30pm – 8:00pm starts September 15<sup>th</sup>
  - Scouts Monday 6:30pm – 8:00pm starts September 13<sup>th</sup>

## Dues

- Dues are \$1/week.
- Dues should be submitted even if your child misses a meeting.

## Attendance

- Attendance at all weekly meetings and activities is expected from all Cubs and Scouts.
- If the youth cannot come to a meeting then it is their responsibility to notify a leader (the patrol leader in the case of Scouts).
- If there are multiple unexplained absences, then the youth may be asked to leave to make room for someone on the waiting list.

## Fundraising

- Due to parent request, the only mandatory fundraising we request of the youth is attendance at the traditional annual Apple Day.
