- Please list an email address if possible. We use this for communicating activity information.
- Ensure that both a full street address and PO Box/Rural Route number are given.

Be a leader!

- Adults who enjoy camping and playing with kids, and want to have some fun, should contact us for available roles.

Uniform

- Full uniform is mandatory for all youth.
 - Beavers: Vest and hat.
 - Cubs: Scouts Canada tan shirt, Cub sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Cub handbook.
 - Scouts: Scouts Canada tan shirt, Scout sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Scout handbook.
 - Venturers: Scouts Canada tan shirt, navy blue trousers/shorts.
- The trousers/shorts must be a solid colour: no stripes, flowers, embroidery, etc.

Cost

- The registration fee is \$175 for the first child, and \$140 for each subsequent child. Break down as follows:
 - \$125 - Scouts Canada registration fee (covers administrative expenses, none remains with the group).
 - \$35 - Group fee to cover \$125 registration fee for each leader. Once per family.
 - \$15 - Community centre rental. The Village of Merrickville requires that we collect and submit this tax.
- Cheques should be made payable to "Scouts Canada" and may be postdated no later than September 30th.
- No refunds available after September 30th.
- Financial assistance is available for registration, uniforms, handbooks, and activities/events.

Meetings

- All meetings are weekly, except Venturers who meet bi-weekly.
