## Potential Changes for Next Year

- Are there any racing style events that could be included to make the outing more interesting for the Scouts?
- What about moving the Scout races to Friday evening or Sunday morning to allow the Saturday to be dedicated to the Cubs? This would create less confusion and noise, as well as allowing the times to be shifted a little later.
- Split the Cub racing so half is performed before lunch, have a lunch break, and then to the second half. This should help prevent the Cubs from getting so restless. The day could also start a little later. Ideally, a game outside (weather permitting) after lunch would help burn off so excess energy.
- Build a platform to allow the Cubs and Scouts to easily set their own cars and trucks on the track. This will give them more responsibility for the race outcome.
- Open Kub Kar racing to white tail Beavers. Give them the choice of participating in Beaver Buggies or Kub Kars.
- Add in formal adult racing.
