- Deep scratch through gelcoat in a canoe by Kanata group. Will be repaired and charged back to their group. No donation received yet from this group.
- o Picnic tables, spars (from Scout room), and manila lashing rope stored in tractor trailer.
- o Plan to apply for another CIAF grant for flat water and whitewater canoes.
- Cave simulator borrowed by Almonte (Bill & Stella Lawrence) for a centenary celebration on September 29th.
- o One climbing harness lost by Venturers when canoe overturned. Venturers will be replacing it.
- One Scout tent (yellow fly) leaks through the floor. All tents should always be used with ground sheets to protect the floor.
- Scout tent(s) missing pegs.
