Format

Each Patrol will camp under the Leadership of their Patrol Leader, in the site assigned to them but not in their normal Group Site. Two Patrols, form different Troops will camp next one another. For safety, two Leaders (from different Troops) will be assigned to camp next to each pair of Patrols. These Leaders will keep the Patrols' extra fuel at their camp and will supervise the filling of lanterns and stoves when applicable. (For example: Patrols from Merrickville and Almonte might camp at the Carleton Place and Drummond sites with Leaders from Smiths Falls and Perth camped between them.) Leaders not assigned to camp with the Patrols will camp in the field near Head Quarters.

The Patrols will be marked on their Camping Skills throughout the weekend and their Scouting Skills during the various activities. Each Patrol will have their weekend menu and duty roster posted in the kitchen area of their campsite. The marking for the Camping Skills will cover such things as: leadership, teamwork, hygiene, camp layout, cooking skills, rotation of duties, neatness of tents and campsite and safety. The Patrols will be marked down for 'interference' by their own Leaders.

Each Patrol will host an assigned Leader for Saturday's supper.
