Voyageur Council and Ducks Unlimited are pleased to announce the 10th annual Green Wing, Scouts Canada Conservation Camp. As usual it will be held at the Upper Canada Bird Sanctuary near Morrisburg Ontario. The camp gives your Scout the opportunity to handle wild ducks at the bird banding station, participate in constructing wood duck and song bird nesting boxes, go on marsh walks, watch as retriever dogs are put through there paces, participate in a formal campfire, participate in the onsite station of Jamboree on the Air, and camp on the shores of the St Lawrence river. The camp fee includes a 1-year membership in Ducks Unlimited Green Wing club including a 1-year subscription for the Conservator Magazine. There are door prizes for all youth. A crest designed specifically for this year's event will be included. There will be other activities run during the weekend to help round out the program.

The consent form (attached) and payment (\$45) are due by October 4th. After that date, but by October 11th, the cost is \$50. Method of payment is cash or cheque payable to "Alex Beelich".

The cost includes a \$20 program fee charged by the camp organisers, a \$4 camping fee for the bird sanctuary, and \$21 to cover the troop cost of food, fuel, etc.

The distance from Merrickville to Morrisburg is approximately 100km, thus car pooling is recommended. A map is attached.
